Remembering Mike Long

Malliotakis, Quaglione praise his leadership, integrity

U.S. Rep. Nicole Malliotakis on Wednesday joined members of the New York Republican congressional delegation in honoring the life and legacy of longtime New York State Conservative Party Chairman Michael Long.

Long, who for many years co-owned Long's Wine and Liquor Depot in Bay Ridge with his brother, Tom, passed away on Sunday at the age of 82. He also was honored by the Bay Ridge Community Council, the Knights of Columbus and other organizations; and was active in the campaigns of Sen. Al D'Amato, Gov. George Pataki and others.

For many years, Long lived in the Bay Ridge part of Malliotakis' district, and she was proud to represent him.

"Mike Long was somebody who truly believed in faith, freedom, the American Dream, and family," Malliotakis said. "He was not just a Marine who served our country, he was a member of the New York City Council, a small-business owner, and the chairman of the Conservative Party. He made such an impression and was so influential in our city and state politics for decades, and still continues to be because of his leadership.

"I owe a lot of my success to Michael Long.

Thank you for all you've done for our community, the delegation, our city and our country. You will be sincerely missed," she added.

Mike Long also had a huge impact on a young community activist and political hopeful named John Quaglione, who currently serves as deputy press secretary for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Brooklyn and previously served as deputy chief of staff and press secretary for former State Sen. Marty Golden.

Paying tribute to the unique leadership characteristics of Long, Quaglione sent the following remembrance. It reads, in part:

"They say in life it's not every day you meet someone special, but for the last nearly 30 years, I knew a unique, passionate, classy, one-of-a-kind man named Mike Long. I was always impressed by how down-to-earth he was, no matter if he just spoke to the governor, the mayor, or the president. When you were talking to him, he made you feel like you mattered the most. And so, I thought to share two stories of my friendship with Mike Long as we mourn his loss, which exemplifies the kind of man he was.

"At one of my first New York State Conservative Party dinners, Gov. George Pataki was the featured speaker. I was waiting with a pen and the evening's journal for an autograph, but the governor had no time to stop. Out of nowhere, I felt the book and the pen taken from my hand and overheard the words, 'Governor, please sign this.' And then it was returned to me. By who, you might ask. By Mike Long," Quaglione said.

"And another time, shortly after I lost my 2017 NYC Council campaign, I was walking intentionally with my head down along Fifth Avenue. As I took steps forward, I noticed a person's shadow on the ground, and I knew I had to look up. I made eye contact with this man who said to me, 'Never walk with your head down. Be proud of yourself no matter what.' The shadow, the man, was Mike Long," he added.

"If there were only more like Mike Long, this country would be better off. Mike was a respectful debater who stood firm in his beliefs. A humble man despite such power and success. Always the best speaker at an event."



Woman sexually assaulted at home



Gil Hodges gets his due in Cooperstown


There was relief, weeping and finally some closure for the Hodges family.

Gil Hodges, the Brooklyn Dodgers' ever-reliable first baseman and manager of the 1969 Miracle Mets, was inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame Sunday afternoon in Cooperstown, N.Y., some 205 miles from where the sporting icon began his legend at Ebbets Field.

"He would be so proud. Today I am especially happy for my mother," Irene Hodges said during a very touching speech ahead of her father's official enshrinement.

Denied entry despite driving in more runs than any big league first baseman in the 1950s, helping the Dodgers win their only World Series title in Brooklyn in 1955 and guiding the Amazin' Mets to their first-ever championship, Gil Hodges got the call last December by the Golden Days Era Committee.

"When the call came from the Hall of Fame ... I began sobbing probably as much as I did when

I lost my father," noted Irene Hodges.

"I was so beyond happy for him, and even thrilled that my mom at 95 would be able hear this news. My mom is watching today from our home in Brooklyn."

The Hodges family was a fixture here in Sheepshead Bay and surrounding areas following the patriarch's passing at the age of 47 due to a heart attack in 1972, when he was preparing to manage the Mets that season.

Though his years of eligibility for getting voted into the Hall by baseball writers came and went, Hodges was always the subject of the Cooperstown debate.

Not only did he drive in just over 1,000 runs in the '50s, but he also spearheaded the Dodg-

ers to seven pennants during his playing career, culminating in the celebrated '55 championship over the hated Yankees and the 1959 world title in Los Angeles vs. the Chicago White Sox.

"He knew he was a good ballplayer. He was consistent. He was strong," Irene Hodges told MLB.com.

"But he felt there were so many other ballplayers that he had such respect for. They were the top of baseball. He never felt (he was a Hall of Famer) about himself."

But now he is, and it was long overdue.

Hodges transitioned to the managerial side in 1963 with the Washington Senators, but made his biggest impact from the dugout with the '69 Mets, who went from National League laughingstocks to one of the most memorable championship teams in our city's history.

New York knocked off Baltimore in five games that October to grab the Fall Classic in Flushing, N.Y., further cementing Hodges' legacy across the five boroughs, even if Brooklyn will always be considered his baseball home.

"My dad had the most amazing smile from ear to ear," Irene Hodges said. "That day will stand out forever. He was still in uniform. He had his hat on. He was just standing there smiling saying, 'Can you believe this?' I could see it like it was vesterday."

Hodges' widow, Joan, who is 95, couldn't attend the ceremony in Cooperstown, though her daughter indicated that she did take in the sights via television from her Brooklyn home.

Joan Hodges was able to receive the initial news late last year when the long-awaited hall call finally came in.

"I hadn't even told my mother about the voting because I didn't want her to be disappointed," Irene revealed in December. "And I didn't want her to think about it... I said, 'Mommy they want to tell you that Daddy is voted into the Hall of Fame.' And she put her hand on her chest and said 'Really? He really did it? Oh Gil, I'm so happy."

Gil Hodges Jr., who spearheaded his father's candidacy for many years, also took the hall matter to heart, even if Gil Sr., refused to.

"Being the only boy I got to travel a lot with him and the Hall of Fame was never a subject again," Gil Jr. said. "We're speaking about someone that was 47 years old (when he died). So, no one thinks at 47 that not only your career is coming to an end, but your existence."

"But he was the type of person who, if he were alive through all of this process through the 30-some odd times... he would have taken each one in stride. It would have never been anything that he would get upset about."

Nothing to get upset about any longer. Brooklyn's own Gil Hodges is a Hall of Famer at last. Even if he was one all along.

After winning four out of six games at home against Greensboro, the Cyclones resumed play after the Major League All-Star break

Coming off a good homestand, the Cyclones were anxious to test their momentum in a three-game weekend road series against the Jersey Shore Blue Claws. That newfound momentum actually carried the team as they swept the series with a display of power and strong pitching.

Starting off on Friday night, the Mets' No. 4 prospect, outfielder Alex Ramirez, lit the fuse with a first-inning home run and then proceeded to go 4-for-5 with five RBIs. Righthander Carson Seymour (1-5) earned his first win of the season while striking out 10 batters over six innings in the 10-3 win.

The next day, Ramirez followed up the previous night's power surge with another home run to win the game in the ninth inning with the bases loaded with Brooklyn trailing 7-5. Turning quickly on a high inside pitch, Ramirez hit the ball deep to left field for a "no-doubter," as described by Cyclones radio announcer Keith Raad. Righty Justin Courtney pitched a scoreless bottom of the ninth in Brooklyn's 9-7 comeback victory.

In the weekend finale, Joe Suozzi was the hitting star, going 3-for-3 with two runs scored and two RBIs in the Cyclones 5-1 win. Holding the Blue Claws to just one run over five innings, Brooklyn's top pitcher Nick Zwack (5-1 with a 1.52 ERA) struck out seven batters and gave

up four hits.

After coming up to join the team from Low Single-A St. Lucie on July 4, Ramirez is beginning to live up to his billing. So far the 6-foot-3, 170-pound 19-year-old Dominican is hitting for power as advertised and his strong arm and outfield speed are sufficient to keep him in the starting lineup. Over his last five games the lanky outfielder is hitting .652 (12-20).

With a three-game sweep of the Blue Claws, the 14-10 Cyclones are now in second place in the South Atlantic League's North Division, just a half game behind the first place (14-9) Hudson Valley Renegades. 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AS MONKEYPOX SPREADS, FAITH NETWORKS FIGHT STIGMA

Faith leaders from a range of religions are teaming up with World Health Organization officials to help prevent monkeypox as outbreaks of the disease occur across the globe.

Religions for Peace Secretary-General Azza Karam said "theologies of compassion" that developed in response to HIV/AIDS, Ebola and COVID-19 are shaping the plans being put in place to address the latest disease that is drawing their attention

"There have been some very serious concerns about the fact that, like HIV, this is bringing back some of the stigma issues that people had thought they had overcome," Karam told Religion News Service Thursday (July 14), "because of the relevance or the fact that men having sex with men are also amongst the groups most likely to suffer it."

Karam said leaders of her organizations from Africa to the United Kingdom are sharing health advice and will recommend approaches that are approved by WHO and informed by faith.

Those leaders are reminding churches, synagogues, mosques, temples and other faith communities of the importance of dwelling on helping people who are unwell and not judging how they may have gotten sick, she said.

"There is no shame in having any disease" is their mantra after dealing with past health crises, she said.

Scholars have long seen a connection between religious beliefs and shame-related stigma about HIV. A 2009 study of HIV and religion in Tanzania — surveying Catholic, Lutheran and Pentecostal churchgoers — found a significant percentage believed that HIV was a divine punishment and that HIV-infected people had not followed the Word of God

But some religious leaders, including South African Archbishop Desmond Tutu before his death last year, have sought to counter such stigma.

"I always say: Let us, as a church, speak out and speak up," Tutu told Independent Catholic News in 2000. "HIV/AIDS is not God's punishment for sin. You have got to say that quite firmly and categorically."

At a webinar hosted July 13 by WHO and Religions for Peace — which includes five regional interreligious councils and more than 90 interreligious networks — scientific and religious experts highlighted the need to make more people familiar with the disease.

"Despite several countries reporting on monkeypox outbreak, many of us are not as yet familiar or aware of it as we need to be in order to take action," Deepika Singh, RFP's associate secretary-general

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Durant waiting for exit from Brooklyn

Nets still holding out for more in trade as summer wears on

It's hard to believe a generational talent like Kevin Durant isn't drawing more buzz or interest on the NBA trade market-but the Brooklyn Nets remain steadfast and prudent.

They don't want to simply ship the former two-time NBA Finals MVP to the first attractive or available suitor.

Instead, Nets general manager Sean Marks and team owner Joseph Tsai are waiting for a haul that would keep Brooklyn on the NBA map as a legitimate title contender, or at least set the team up for the not-so-distant future.

Judging from the ongoing standstill and several ill-fated rumored deals, both parties are apparently willing to wait it out.

Boston is the latest locale Durant may or may not be headed to depending on who you listen to

The Celtics and Nets reportedly exchanged ideas on a potential deal a few weeks ago, but nothing has materialized as of yet.

Boston star Jayson Tatum attended the premiere of the Showtime documentary, "NYC Point Gods", which Durant got an executive producer credit for, earlier this week.

But Tatum remained mum on the matter of a rumored blockbuster deal that would send Jaylen Brown from Beantown to Brooklyn.

"I played with [Durant] during the Olympics," Tatum said Tuesday. "Obviously, he's a great player, but that's not my decision. I love our team. I love the guys that we got."

So would the Nets if Durant and fellow superstar Kyrie Irving, who is back on his \$36.5 million option for next season but also on the trade block, returned to Brooklyn for one more run at the franchise's first-ever NBA title and our borough's first major pro sports championship since 1955.

"I love our team," Tatum reiterated. "I just go out there and play with my teammates. I don't put that [general manager] hat on to make decisions."

Marks does wear that hat, and Tsai and his wife Clara will be in on any deal that could alter not only the NBA landscape, but the Nets' ongoing tenure here as a viable championship squad.

A swap sending Irving to the Los Angeles Lakers for Russell Westbrook never seemed to get off the ground, and now Durant is waiting for the Nets to get exactly what they want in trade.

Otherwise, two disgruntled superstars could be headed to training camp in September here in Brooklyn without a new team.

How that may impact their current franchise is yet to be determined.

The borough is on standby, along with Durant, Irving and the rest of the Nets, many of whom are doubtless wondering when, or if, they'll ever hit the hardwood with the high-priced tandem again.

In local college sports news, the Long Island University baseball team, fresh off making historic run to the NCAA Regionals, has earned yet another accolade.

The reigning Northeast Conference champions learned Wednesday that they earned the American Baseball Coaches Association Team Academic Excellence Award for the sixth consec-

and director of programs, said on the webinar.

Monkeypox — so-called because it was initially found in a monkey in a Copenhagen research lab in 1958 — was first seen in humans when a 9-monthold in Congo contracted the disease in 1970.

There are now more than 10,000 human cases globally outside Africa, said Rosamund Lewis, WHO's technical lead for monkeypox, during the webinar. In Europe, 98% of confirmed cases are among men who have had sex with other men. Among suspected cases in the Congo Basin of Africa, two-thirds are men, 25% to 30% are women and the rest are children.

Overall, there are recent cases in more than 60 countries where monkeypox has not previously been detected.

The virus can include a rash or lesions that can remain infectious for two to four weeks, as well as fever and sometimes painful swollen lymph nodes, said Lewis. Some sufferers require intensive-care hospitalization.

She said some countries are beginning to obtain vaccines and other treatments but "it's not something that happens overnight."

"We have a very different presentation of the outbreak, or several outbreaks, which complicates the picture in terms of messaging and risk communications," Lewis said. "We're dealing with a major outbreak in men who have sex with men globally, much of which will be underreported, but at the same time, anyone can get monkeypox. It takes direct contact, skin-to-skin contact, face-to-face contact, but it's not a sexually transmitted infection, or at least not exclusively."

Andy Seale, an adviser to the WHO's program on HIV, hepatitis and sexually transmitted infections, said lessons from COVID-19 and HIV especially could prove helpful for faith leaders addressing monkeypox as dozens of countries face it for the first time.

"Particularly the work from HIV that many of you have been involved in over the decades, support to people living with HIV and addressing stigma and discrimination," Seale said, "that kind of experience is critical for how we start to really think about monkeypox."

Francis Kuria, secretary-general of the African Council of Religious Leaders, a regional interreligious body of RFP, said officials of faith communities are prepared to work with health authorities in disseminating accurate information and appropriate messages.

"Religious leaders will be at hand to work with you to develop key messaging that can help contain any stigma that may arise," said Kuria.

Seale said faith leaders can also be voices of calm, dispelling misinformation and offering practical assistance to people who may need to spend two to four weeks in isolation.

"We really need to be sure that we don't unintentionally stereotype, stigmatize, blame or shame, any of these communities," Seale said of those dealing with monkeypox. "If someone discloses that they've had monkeypox, I think we need to be careful that we react without being judgmental, or making any assumptions about how they may have become infected."

Just as houses of worship have distributed food during the COVID-19 pandemic, he said, similar assistance may be needed, for example, by zero-hour contract workers who are not guaranteed any pay during isolation or others affected by cost-of-living increases

"We have to recognize that isolation because of monkeypox is an additional challenge very similar to what we're seeing around poverty and COVIDrelated problems," he said.


Intrepid and indefatigable: BROOKLYN'S KATY TUR

Five years ago, MSNBC reporter Katy Tur wrote a compelling memoir about covering the 2016 Trump campaign, "Unbelievable: My Front Row Seat to the Craziest Campaign in American History." It quickly rose to Number 1 on the *New York Times* Best-Seller list. Now Tur, who is not even 40 and lives with her family in Brooklyn, has written a second memoir, "Rough Draft." It's a much different, deeper book, one in which she exhumes some long buried toys in the attic.

That she was able to write the book while anchoring her own 2:00 p.m. MSNBC show, getting married (to Tony Dokoupil, now CBS Mornings anchor), becoming pregnant, giving birth to a boy, coping with COVID and another election, having a second child, a daughter — and dealing with the out-of-left-field transitioning of her demanding newscaster, chopper-flying father Bob Tur — speaks to her grit, stamina, focus and determination. The book candidly and colorfully chronicles how she kept it all together.

In April 2013, while on location covering the Boston Marathon bombing for NBC News, Tur's father called to tell her he had decided to become a woman. She nearly choked on the cheeseburger

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she was eating at the time. Her father had always been volatile and intense, with a more-than-occasional violent streak. In a subsequent conversation, he would tell Katy that the violence was due to his ambivalence about his sexuality. But she wouldn't let him off so easily. "It felt like my dad was playing a get-out-of-gender-free card I didn't know existed." She insisted they talk about the violence but her father refused to consider it. This caused an estrangement that still exists

In the foreword of "Rough Draft," Tur described her relationship with her father. "I support her transition and I applaud my father's courage. I also still struggle with my father's past, which is a major part of this book. For that reason, Zoey will be Zoey from the moment of her announcement to me. Before it, Bob will be Bob. Both she and he will always be my father."

Recently I caught up with Tur by phone. Below are edited excerpts from our conversation.

How in the world, with your jammed and frenetic schedule — including being the mom to two toddlers — did you find the time to write the book?

(Laughing) Truthfully, it was a fucking miserable experience. I began writing the book in 2019, before the pandemic. At first it was slow going but eventually I found my stride.

Did you know from the outset that this book would be very different from "Unbelievable?"

My second book was supposed to be the followup to "Unbelievable." But then the pandemic hit and the book slowly morphed into a more personal memoir. I always knew that I'd write about my family but I thought it would be further down the road.

How has being a mother changed, if at all, your approach to your job?

It has deepened my connection to being a reporter. Any experience you have — whether becoming a mother or dealing with a death in the family — makes you a better reporter. It gives you an understanding of what people are going through. And it creates empathy.

In making the transition from reporter to anchor, what were the toughest adjustments?

As a reporter I knew a lot about one subject. As an anchor you need to be informed about everything.

A recent NBC Nightly News broadcast, anchored by Kate Snow, was devoted to one topic: gun violence in five American cities on one night. Would you ever devote your show to one topic?


"Funny you should ask that because I would like to do a single-topic show at some point. I was even thinking of doing one on gun violence in America but Kate beat me to the punch. But there are a myriad of topics to be explored, including, most prominently, climate change."

How did you come to live in Brooklyn?

Well, as you know from interviewing me for "Unbelievable," my first television job in New York was being a reporter for News 12

Brooklyn, so I really got to know the borough. But there's a deeper connection: My maternal grandfather, George John Gerulakos, was born and raised in Brooklyn. In fact, he was a rabid Dodgers fan. He lived on Union Street in Park Slope. He met my grandmother in Brooklyn, married and then moved to Los Angeles, where, oddly enough, he never went to a Dodgers game! My grandfather died while I was in college. I would have loved comparing notes about Brooklyn with him. The reason I moved to Brooklyn is because while often visiting Park Slope, Carroll Gardens, Ft. Greene and Cobble Hill I always thought 'Gee, it would be nice to live in one of those brownstones.' Now we do.

ON THIS DAY IN 1920, the Brooklyn Daily Eagle reported, "Rumors that Charles Ponzi, the Boston high financier who is reputed to have amassed a fortune of \$9,000,000 in a few weeks, will open an office in New York have not been confirmed, and in the meantime the U.S. District Attorney in Manhattan is keeping close watch over the possibility of his coming here. A question that neither officials nor laymen have been able to figure out as yet, in connection with his startling entry into the financial world is: Who is losing the money that Ponzi has made?"

ON THIS DAY IN 1922, the Eagle reported, "Fishermen of the Rockaway trestle colonies along Jamaica Bay are much concerned over reports received during the past week concerning the appearance of a school of sharks and porpoises in the bay the early part of the week. While the species of the shark has not been ascertained thus far, it is assumed by the majority of the angling enthusiasts that the creatures are of the sand variety and not of the man-eating species as a number of persons supposed. Maxwell Kennedy, proprietor of the Breezy Point Hotel at Rockaway Point, stated over a week ago that nothing but a school of sharks could have brought so many fish into Jamaica Bay as that have been inhabiting the waters during the past month. However, up until that time none of the big fish had been observed, but during the past week several reports were received from fishermen who have seen the sharks swimming about the bay ... A number of fishermen were given a surprise on Wednesday while fishing off Black Wall, near Barren Island, when, upon pulling their lines following a bite, they discovered only the heads of weakfish which had taken their hook. Bill Anderson of 32 Bayside Pl., Rockaway Beach, was one of those who had this experience, and said that it had been the work of the sharks. However, the sharks or porpoises are not bothering fishermen near the Rockaway side of the bay."

*** **ON THIS DAY IN 1948**, the *Eagle* reported, "The Big Stench went back to court today for purification. Before Magistrate Abner C. Surpless in Flatbush Court appeared representatives of 40,000 residents in the Marine Park-Jamaica Bay area to press their complaint that the city officials dumping garbage in their midst were guilty of maintaining a public nuisance. That the overwhelming odor wafting from the dumped garbage is a nuisance in the ordinary meaning of that word most of the 40,000 living in the afflicted area are fully convinced. The dumping has been carried out, for the past six months or more, in the shallow water off Jamaica Bay, at Flatbush Ave. and Avenue W, on the site of what is to become a municipal golf course. Spread by wind and tide and rotted by the summer sun, the garbage gives forth an overpowering smell which destroys the appetite, makes sleep difficult, causes children to vomit and adults to cry out in disgust. Tiny particles rising from the soggy garbage afloat in the air leave a film of muck on everything, and turn polished silver black, the complainants say, in a matter of minutes."

ON THIS DAY IN 1954, the Eagle reported, "The city's juvenile delinquency rate is increasing with growing speed, according to new figures made public by Mayor [Robert] Wagner. In the first six months of this year, the mayor said, delinquency jumped 17.2 percent over the same six months last year. The figure last year, he added, was an increase of 13.2 percent over the first six months of the previous year. Despite the big jump in New York, the mayor added, the increase has been even more marked in some other parts of the state and nation. Speaking at the concluding dinner of the annual New York State Association of Chiefs of

Police in the Hotel New Yorker, he said only an overall community-supported program could cure the growing evil. He declared the rise in juvenile crime might be related to 'the inadequate support, judicially, psychiatrically and in terms of existing law' given the police in meeting the problem. Necessary tools, he said, are parental education, slum clearance, religious education, trained probationary and psychiatric personnel and adequately staffed and compensated police forces."

WASHINGTON (U.P.) -Mysterious objects swooped over the nation's capital again early today and the Air Force called in top scientists to find out what the "flying saucers"

The Civil Aeronautics Administration traffic control center reported that its radar picked up the objects for about six straight hours early this morning.

The objects, a CAA official said, were traveling about 100 to 120 miles per hour in a 10-mile arc around the capital, between Herndon, Va., and Andrews Air Force Base in nearby Maryland.

It was in this same area that radar screens recorded the strange "targets" the past two Saturday nights, setting off a new rash of "flying saucer" rumors in the capital.

Top Air Force brass has decided to get to the bottom of the mystery. Forsaking an earlier attitude that "there ain't not such animal," they are enlisting top scientists in a major new saucer study, it was learned today.

A CAA official said the control center radar first started picking up the strange "blips" about 1:30 a.m. and that they continued showing up on the radarscope until 6 a.m. this morning. At some times, he said, there were as many as eight to 12 of the objects on the scope at the same time.

A pilot aboard an Eastern Air Lines Constellation was directed to check on the objects about 3 a.m., but he reported he saw no lights despite a 15-mile visibility. The CAA official said the objects disappeared from the radar screen when the plane was in the area where they had been tracked and "then came back in behind him."

No jets from the Air Defense Command were sent up to chase the new objects as on Saturday. Then a jet pilot reported sighting "steady white lights," but said his 600-milean-hour jet was unable to "close in."

The CAA said it did not alert the Air Defense Command this time because it was unable to get visual confirmation from commercial airline pilots. The Air Force said it failed to pick up the tell-tale "blips" on its Andrews base radar screens.

The official said the objects appeared much the same as on last Saturday night except that there was not "quite as much definition" to the "blips." He described the "blips" as the same kind as made by an airplane but with "lighter intensity."

The Air Force will rely primarily on physicists for its "flying saucer" investigation. This is in line with a tentative opin-

ion already reached in some Air Force circles that variously described mystery objects in the sky actually are physical phenomena, however imperfectly understood up to now, rather than actual flying discs.

A high Air Force officer, who informed the United Press of these developments, said, "We are fairly well convinced that the so-called 'flying saucers' are not anything posing a threat to the air defense of the United States."

Meanwhile, Maj. Gen. John A. Samford, Air Force director of intelligence, went into a second day of "saucer" conferences with his experts.

Air Force spokesmen insisted there was no military secrecy veiling the quest for "saucer" data. Any seeming reluctance to give out information was based unhappily on ignorance, not on military security, they said.

Sources who have followed the "saucer" saga through five years asserted with renewed vigor that the glowing, varicolored objects sighted visually all over the land, and recently by radar, are not secret aircraft or weapons developments.

Short shrift was being given, too, to the idea that the whirling discs were ethereal, extra-terrestrial, inter-planetary or of Communist persua-


See 'saucer' take leisurely jaunt over Manhattan

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
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

Flatbush Man Gets Three to Six Years for Running Red Light, Fatally Striking Deliveryman in Borough Park

On Thursday, July 28, a Flatbush man was sentenced three-to-six years for running a red light and striking a deliveryman in Borough Park. The sentencing was a result of a trial before Supreme Court Justice John Hecht. Valdez Heron, 31, of Flatbush, pleaded guilty to second-degree manslaughter on June 6, 2020.

On October 18, 2020, around the time of 11:50 a.m., Heron was driving a 2015 Dodge Charger eastbound on 46th Street toward 9th Avenue when he ran a steady red light and struck Xiang Wu, 43, a deliveryman, as he rode a scooter through the intersection. Wu was thrown over the hood of the Dodge Charger onto the pavement due to the force of impact.

Heron then jumped out of the car while it was still in drive, causing the Charger to roll down the street and strike a parked car. He was arrested at the scene.

Wu was taken in critical condition to Maimonides Medical Center and underwent multiple surgeries. On November 25, he was transferred to the Bedford Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation in Bed-Stuy. In December of 2020, the victim was found unresponsive and transferred to Woodhull Medical Center, where he was pronounced dead. The medical examiner determined the cause of death to be the complications of the injury.

District Attorney Eric Gonzalez said,

"This defendant's recklessness behind the wheel tragically took the life of a hardworking husband and father. He has now been held accountable for his actions. I am committed to keeping Brooklyn's roads safe for all people."

AG Sues CVS for Harming Safety Net Hospitals, Clinics

The Attorney General sued CVS Health Corporation on Friday, July 29, under violations of antitrust law and harm done to safety net hospitals in New York. Allegedly, CVS owned and operated a subsidiary it used to obtain federal subsidies on prescriptions, also draining public funds by forcing safety net hospitals to exclusively use Wellpartner, a third-party administrator (TPA), and incur millions in additional costs through retraining and hiring staff, while CVS benefited through its subsidiary.

"While safety net health care providers are tackling public health crises and helping underserved communities, CVS is robbing them of millions of desperately needed funds that could improve patient care," said Attorney General Letitia James.

The federal 340B program allows safety net hospitals and clinics to purchase drugs at discounted prices and allot funding elsewhere. Hospitals who use the 340B program must contract with pharmacies, and the suit alleges that CVS never contracted with New York safety hospitals who use Wellpartner, a violation of New York antitrust law. The absence of a contract means that hospitals and clinics who receive 340B subsidies could not collect the funds which were rightfully theirs and comply with Wellpartner and CVS' scheme.

Through her lawsuit, Attorney General James is seeking injunctive relief, equitable monetary relief for the lost revenue and additional costs safety net health care providers were forced to incur, and civil penalties for CVS's unfair and illegal business practices. In addition, Attorney General James seeks to require CVS to inform all safety net health care providers that they are not required to exclusively use Wellpartner.

"CVS's actions are a clear example of a large corporation using its clout and power to take advantage of institutions and vulnerable New Yorkers, but my office will not allow it. We are taking action to stop CVS's harmful practices and recoup critical funds to improve health care for our communities. When powerful corporations undermine the health and wellbeing of vulnerable communities in New York, they can expect to hear from my office."

The lawsuit alleges that CVS's actions undermined the goal of the 340B program and hurt the financial condition of safety net health care providers. CVS required health care providers to transition at a significant cost to Wellpartner if the hospitals wanted to obtain 340B revenues from prescriptions filled at CVS pharmacies. Many hospitals switched to Wellpartner for all their 340B needs because it was not practical or economical to pay for two TPAs. In addition, CVS knew that the 340B program rules do not allow hospitals to steer patients away from certain pharmacies, so health care providers had no choice in practice — if they didn't go along with CVS's scheme, they simply couldn't collect 340B savings for patients who choose to go to CVS pharmacies.

The litigation is being handled on behalf

of New York by Assistant Attorneys General Jeremy Kasha and Olga Kogan and Senior Enforcement Counsel Bryan Bloom of the Antitrust Bureau, under the supervision of Deputy Bureau Chief Amy McFarlane and Bureau Chief Elinor Hoffmann. The Antitrust Bureau is a part of the Division for Economic Justice, which is led by Chief Deputy Attorney General Chris D'Angelo and overseen by First Deputy Attorney General Jennifer Levy.

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Man who accosted US Rep. Zeldin on stage remains jailed

A man who accosted U.S. Rep. Lee Zeldin on stage as the Republican campaigned for governor will remain in custody while a federal judge considers his lawyer's plea to release the Army veteran, who he said was in an alcoholic relapse.

David Jakubonis, 43, faces a federal count of assaulting a member of Congress with a dangerous weapon for the attack July 21 in the Rochester area. The charge carries a potential maximum penalty of 10 years in prison.

At a detention hearing Thursday, assistant U.S. Attorney Sean Eldridge argued Jakubonis should be held as a danger to the community who lunged at a congressman with a dangerous weapon.

"To characterize what happened to Congressman Zeldin that day as a close call is an understatement," Eldridge said.

A video of the attack shows Jakubonis raised his arm toward the congressman from Long Island as he held a keychain with two sharp points.

"You're done," Jakubonis said four times as he approached Zeldin.

Zeldin grabbed Jakubonis' wrist and the two tussled to the ground as others jumped in to help. Zeldin suffered a minor scrape.

Defense attorney Steven Slawinski said Jakubonis was only reaching for Zeldin's microphone to stop him from talking, under the mistaken belief Zeldin was disrespecting veterans. He blamed the episode on a relapse triggered by a breakup with a girlfriend.

"Mr. Jakubonis, if he is drinking, does have a problem holding his liquor," the lawyer said, adding that Jakubonis also has been prescribed psychiatric medication that can interact poorly with alcohol.

Slawinski sought either probation with strict conditions or inpatient care. Jakubonis, he said, was an admitted alcoholic who sought treatment throughout his adult life. He developed severe anxiety and panic attacks while serving

a year in Iraq, the lawyer said, and his mental health declined further after he witnessed the sudden death of his wife of seven years from a cerebral hemorrhage three years ago.

"That would send anyone into a sprial," Slawinski told the court.

After his wife's death, Jakubonis relinquished custody of his children to his brother and sister-in-law. Slawinski said Jakubonis has not seen his children since because it is too painful to see them call anyone else mom and dad.

Judge Marian Payson said she would make a detention decision after considering whether Jakubonis' actions last week were "aberrant" behavior and whether there is enough support in place if he is released from jail. She said she wanted to review Jakubonis' mental health history.

The judge also asked prosecutors to send her a photo of the object — which Eldridge called a "cat dagger" — and its dimensions, noting that Jakubonis was released

after his initial arrest on a state charge. She asked whether opinions differed on whether the plastic object was considered "a dangerous weapon."

"It is not designed to be a decoration. It's designed to be a weapon," Eldridge said. "The points are very pointy and the material is hard enough that it could puncture the skin."

The federal criminal complaint filed Saturday said Jakubonis "did not know who the speaker was or that the speaker was a political person." It said that when Jakubonis watched video of the incident he told investigators he "must have checked out" and that what was depicted in the video was disgusting.

Jakubonis was arraigned Friday on a separate

state charge of attempted assault in the second degree and was released by a local judge.

He has two prior misdemeanor DWI convictions from 2006 and 2019. His two-year probation on the 2019 count expired in December 2021.

A big part of Zeldin's campaign message has been a promise to get tougher on criminals. Almost immediately after the on-stage altercation with Jakubonis, he sought to link a New York bail reform law passed by Democrats to his own case.

The law requires judges to free most people accused of lesser crimes while they await trial. It limits the instances when judges can require a defendant to pay money to gain

their freedom, a system that favored wealthier people.

When he was initially arrested, a Monroe County sheriff's investigator charged Jakubonis with second-degree attempted assault, a crime not serious enough to warrant his jailing or the imposition of bail.

Afterward, Zeldin tweeted that his assailant's release was "due to New York's insane cashless bail law."

Democrats pointed out that if prosecutors had wanted to give a judge discretion to jail Jakubonis, Monroe County District Attorney Sandra Doorley — a Republican who is listed as being a cochair of Zeldin's campaign — could have simply picked a more serious charge.

MIKE LONG, 1940-2022

Former New York State Conservative Party Chairman Mike Long died July 24 at age 82. He had been ill but, frankly, in the manner in which Mike lived his life, you would not have known it until close to the end.

He was a wonderful friend, a truly great man who will be missed by most everyone who had an opportunity to know him. Many have contacted me, using superlatives such as "good," "decent," "loyal," "finest," "respectful" and "a man of his word," among so many wonderful comments that I have lost count.

Some who may have seen things from a different point of view were quick to point out that he was respected and highly regarded by his opponents. A truly awesome compliment.

Mike and his wife Eileen raised nine children who

gave them 24 grandchildren and five great-grandchildren so far. Their travels brought them from Cypress Hills, where Mike ran an ice cream parlor with his brother Tom, to Bay Ridge. Mike made all his own ice cream and many confectionery products. It was an effort to get in the door near Easter or Christmas.

The Longs moved to Bay Ridge in 1982, while Mike was in the City Council, and settled in a big house on 76th Street. Tom and Mike operated Long's Wine and Liquor Depot on Fifth Avenue and 79th Street until they sold it about 10 years ago.

Beginning in the mid-1970s the family had a summer cottage and then a home in Breezy Point. They moved to Breezy full-time about four years ago but frequently visited friends and acquaintances in Bay Ridge. The Bay Ridge Community Council gave Mike its coveted Civic Award in 2016. He contributed a great deal to the civic, educational and business life of the community over the decades. He also received great praise for his civic, educational and business contributions in Cypress Hills, where he was the elected president of the community school board.

Mike is best known as the longtime chairman of the state Conservative Party. For all of my political career, we were linked through this involvement.

In 1977, just out of high school, I met Mike while he was managing a New York City mayoral campaign. He had been the party's Brooklyn chairman since 1972. Through this meeting, I became involved in the party, eventually becoming his



Brooklyn party executive director. In 1988, when he became state chairman, I became Brooklyn chairman and, four years later, one of his vice chairmen. When he retired in early 2019, I was fortunate enough to be elected state chairman.

As Brooklyn and state chairman, Mike had a code which centered around his principles. A Marine, Mike wore his solid belief in the greatness of America on his sleeve. He was enormously proud of being an elector for President Ronald Reagan in 1980. He was even chosen by the New York electors to be the secretary of the gathering in Albany.

Many local elected officials benefited from his sage political advice and friendship. In a business in which trust emanates from an eyedropper, Mike was someone all could trust.

He played key roles in electing Sen. Al D'Amato, Gov. George Pataki and Attorney General Dennis Vacco, but his influence could be felt in many congressional, state legislative and local races.

You always knew where you stood with Mike Long, and that, more often than not, was where you would stand with the party. His leadership was gladly followed because he led by listening and valued input.

Mike's political legacy will be the many who learned

from his example, those like myself who he mentored and the many who today or in the near future will create policy in the halls of govern-

Knowing Mike for 45 years, I feel confident in saying that, of the countless awards and recognitions he received, he was most proud of two that are affiliated with the Catholic Church. The Knights of Columbus gave him their Pro Patria Award in 1985 and the church itself made him a Knight in the Order of St. Gregory the Great. This award is one of the highest the church presents to a layman anywhere in the world.

Rest in peace, my friend. Prayers for you Mike, Eileen and the family.

QUITTING TIME

If you are like most people in southern Brooklyn, you know of several people who have contracted COVID the past few weeks. Anecdotally, no matter who you talk to, cases seem to be up considerably as of late. Officially, as far as New York City COVID case rates, not so much.

We have all been through a lot since the pandemic exploded more than 28 months ago. Everyone is not in the same place on how to live with COVID, but we have definitely come a long way and we can continue to readjust to our new normal. Part of that will continue to be accepting that some people will take different approaches to it, depending on their personal risk and comfort levels

Mask mandates may have all gone away, but you will

still see people who choose to mask up indoors. In fact, due to current transmission levels, the official word from the health commissioner is that New Yorkers should be wearing a mask indoors or in crowded outdoor settings.

When New York City COVID protocols were eased a while back and new benchmarks established. mask mandates were supposed to go into effect when transmission rates reached the levels they are at now, but it seems there is no appetite to actually follow those rules. In fact, it appears the only desire is to further remove any COVID precautions, even when spread of the virus is up.

It is highly questionable whether any mask mandate would be observed anyway, but even if we leave it up to individuals from now on to make their own choices on masking, the city should at least be clear with the public as to what the risk is, so they can make fully informed decisions based on current data.

Mayor Eric Adams has been moving in the opposite direction, having stripped away what little was left to inform New Yorkers of current COVID risks and help mitigate community spread. At the beginning of July, as case rates were climbing with the far more transmissible BA.5 variant, Adams quietly ended the city's COVID alert system. When he was asked about the decision July 7, Adams referred to the alert system as "an old weapon," saying that his administration was "going to create new weapons to fight this new war."

Well, more than three



weeks later, as COVID has continued to advance, Adams has not unveiled any of his promised new weapons to combat it. In fact, he has conceded more ground to the viral enemy, seemingly waving the white flag with his decision to close all city-run brick-and-mortar COVID testing sites. Again, we do need to move forward through this pandemic, but quite frankly the New York City mayor is capitulating to COVID

Street to get a free PCR test, as those locations have been shuttered by Adams, who says the focus will be on at-home rapid tests. While those antigen tests are convenient and have become more widely used, there are indications they are taking longer to return positive results in cases of the BA.5 variant. PCR results are also still needed for many New Yorkers to obtain sick time from their employer while quarantining and recovering from COVID.

The other result of less PCR testing is fewer officially recorded COVID cases, which in turn helps justify the rationale to remove more precautions and mitigation methods. Unfortunately, it means those rollbacks are not based on what is actually occurring. Wastewater testing from the Owl's Head Wastewater Treatment Plant in Bay Ridge cannot be skewed, as it detects COVID levels from the wider community. Levels on July 24 were 18 times higher than they were 30 days prior, while city COVID case rates had only increased about one-and-a-half times during the same time period.

Adams says we need to learn to live with COVID. His actions have us in a place where we will need to learn to live with getting COVID again and again. Learning to live with COVID should not mean ending the fight against it.



Borough historian stirs memories of Gil Hodges

It was a piece of memorabilia he acquired more than 20 years ago, which clearly demonstrates how long it took for Hodges to be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame.


The late Marty Adler, an assistant principal at the Jackie Robinson Public School near the former site of Ebbets Field, was an avid Dodgers fan. He told sportswriters and anyone who would listen that Hodges belonged in the Hall of Fame. Adler even established his own Brooklyn Dodgers Hall of Fame and reportedly printed and distributed 5,000 of the Hodges bumper stickers. Adler is also credited with convincing city education officials to name the


school for Jackie Robinson.

Schweiger also brought copies of the original blueprints for Ebbets Field to the luncheon, which took place at the Bay Ridge Manor.

Mezzosoprano Madison Marie McIntosh gave an awesome operatic performance, and Society Vice President Mike Spinner talked about the upcoming 114th annual memorial tribute to America's first POWs, the Prison Ship Martyrs of the American Revolution.
